RE: SB 923 (Becker): Consumer privacy requests – SUPPORT

Dear Senator Becker,

Omidyar Network supports SB 923, which represents a crucial step to strengthen the deletion rights of Californians under the California Consumer Privacy Act (CCPA).

Omidyar Network's philanthropic and investment efforts have continued for more than two decades and stem from our founder's work at two great California companies, PayPal and eBay. We envision a world where our shared humanity steers our digital future. So far, we have committed nearly \$2 billion to initiatives that share our vision.

In recent years, California has significantly improved laws around privacy and transparency in an effort to provide consumers with more control over their personal information. As data brokers collect and sell personal information for profit, mechanisms to limit the collection and use of this data are increasingly critical. The Delete Act, passed in 2023, established an accessible mechanism for consumers to initiate deletion of their personal information with all data brokers registered on the California Data Broker Registry. Unfortunately, under current law, consumers are still unable to delete personal information obtained by a business from a third-party data broker.

SB 923 closes this loophole by enabling consumers to request deletion of *any* personal information that a business holds, including personal information collected about the consumer from third parties. It also requires businesses operating solely online to have a web-based platform – making it easier for Californians to have control over their personal information.

For these reasons, we are pleased to support SB 923 and thank you for bringing forward this important measure.
